In our bylaws, Article 4 Membership section b states:

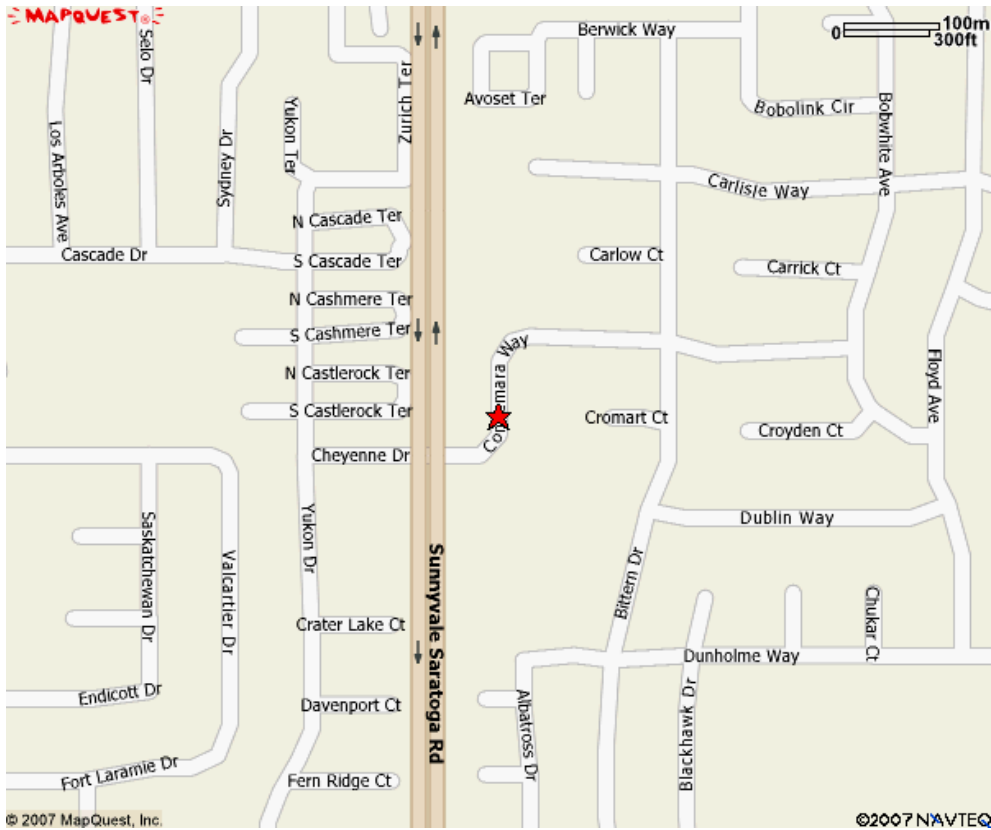
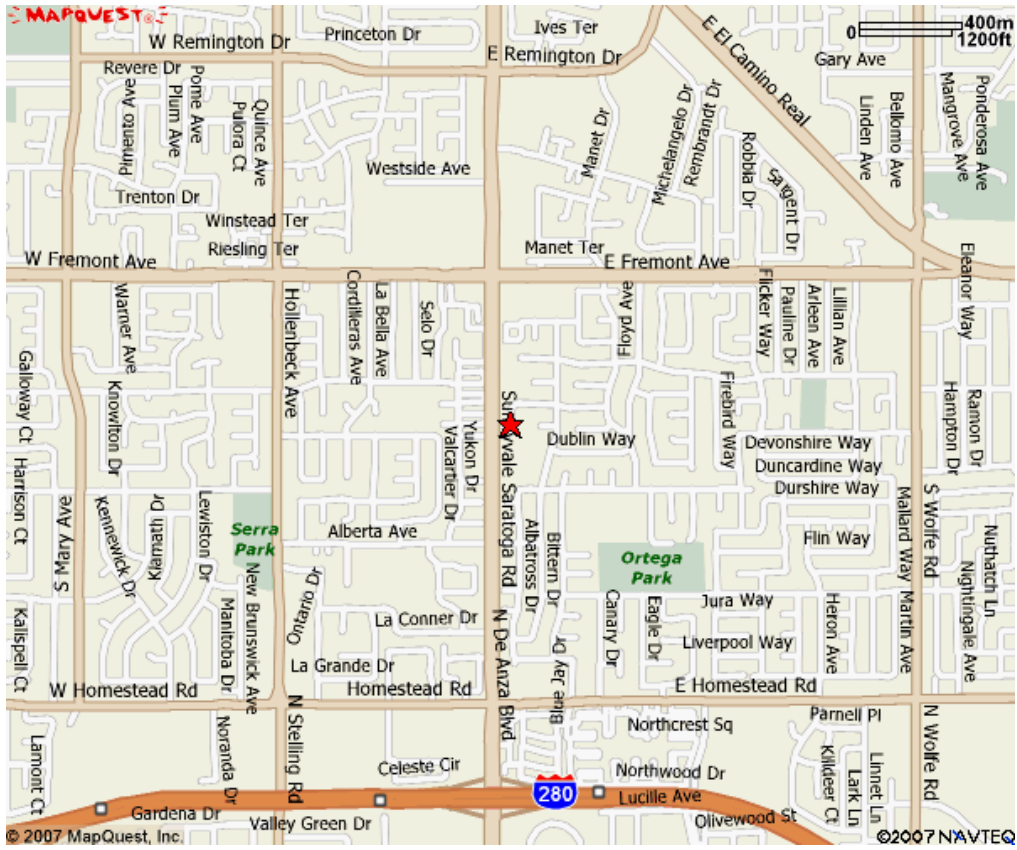
